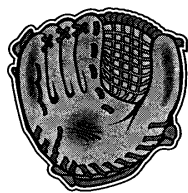

From Your Player Agent: VERY IMPORTANT-PLEASE READ

Can you believe the summer is over and fall is upon us? I know it's hard to think of baseball with other seasonal sports going on but please take a moment to read this entire newsletter. There are important forms and information about tryouts. It is very important to get your child to tryouts, and to get your registration in on time.

For Little League Baseball, the birthday cutoff date for determining playing age is April 30th. If you have a child, who is 8 by April 30th 2012, and you want him/her to play in minors, or 10 by April 30th you want him/her to tryout for majors, you **must get him/her to tryouts**. All 9, 10, & 11 year old players **must all try out**. If the player does not try out, they will not be able to move up. When it comes to draft time, the players who have tried out will be drafted first onto teams. Those who have not tried out will be selected in a secondary draft or put onto a waiting list. We will then decide how many teams we will have in each division by how many players try out. I can't emphasize enough how important it is to get to tryouts.

For softball, the birthday cut-off date for determining playing age is December 31st of 2011.

If you want your child to move up into the next division, they need to get to tryouts

REMINDER: YOU MUST BRING TWO CHECKS TO TRYOUTS: ONE FOR THE REGISTRATION FEE AND A SECOND FOR THE WORK BOND.

Registration for T-Ball and Farm can be mailed in or can be given at the registration time at tryouts. Please remember to register early to get your child on a team.

Registrations (with both checks) need to be in to me by February 15, 2012. When you register, you may request your child to be on a team with friends **in T-Ball and Farm ONLY**. Please put 1 or 2 names down, and as long as it is early enough we will do our best to put them together. There is no guarantee your child will be placed as requested. Registrations received after the deadline cannot be guaranteed a school team or with their friends, **NO EXCEPTIONS**.

We are looking forward to another great season. Last year was one of our best, and we still would like to top that this year. Please come to tryouts and register early so we can keep these teams at a reasonable number and all children can get a lot of playing time. Getting READY for the 2012 Season

Spring registration is currently underway. Please fill out the attached Registration Form and mail in with required payments to PTWLL as soon as possible, but no later than Feb. 15, 2012. Additional forms may be obtained from our website at www.partroywestbaseball.org

Eligibility Requirements:

A player must be:

- A resident of Parsippany-Troy Hills (proof may be required), and
- At least 4 years old, but not more than 16 years of age by
 - April 30, 2012 for Tball/Baseball, or
 - December 31, 2011 for Softball (Farm League and above).

All new registrants MUST provide a birth certificate at registration (and tryouts if required below).

**PTWLL will hold tryouts (and registration) for the 2012 season
at the Par-Troy West Complex on Elmwood Road
on the following dates ONLY:**

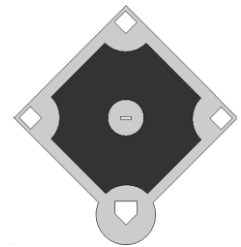
Sunday – September 18th from 6:00pm to 8:00pm
Sunday - September 25th from 1:00pm to 4:00pm

About Tryouts...

Tryouts are for all Baseball and Softball players:

- **Currently in** the Minor League, and
- **Moving up** to Minor, Major and Junior/Senior Leagues.

All Baseball and Softball players who will be Little League age 8 in the coming season are also invited to try out for Minor Leagues if they wish to be considered for moving up to the Minor League.



You **MUST** bring **two checks** with you – one for the registration fee and a second for the work bond.

Managing or Coaching a Team? All those interested in managing or coaching for the upcoming season are encouraged to observe the tryouts. We welcome the help!

Submit this completed registration form along with (2) checks for registration fee and work bond (see below.)

If your child is Little League age 9 or above, currently in Minors, or moving up to Minors, Majors, Juniors/Seniors, then your child MUST attend one of the tryout dates.

FOR FIRST-TIME REGISTRATION ONLY: Registrations will only be accepted in person. In addition to this completed registration form, first-time registries must provide a copy of each child's birth certification along with the registration fee and work bonds (see below). If your child is Little League age 9 or above, your child must also attend one of the tryout dates.

TWO CHECKS, MADE PAYABLE TO PTWLL, ARE REQUIRED TO REGISTER YOUR CHILD (these MUST be brought to tryouts if not mailed in advance):

Check #1: Registration Fee dated today @ \$75.00for (1) child, \$125.00 for (2) children, \$150.00 for (3) children.

Check #2: Work Bond dated May 1, 2012 @ \$50.00 per family. This check will be returned upon completion of one of the services listed below. **Everyone must hand in a work bond.**

**** Candy Buyout:** a separate check, payable to PTWLL @ \$30.00 for each child, if you do not wish to participate in the candy sale fundraiser. You may send this in now or provide it to your team manager at the start of the season.

Returning registrations received after February 15th, 2012 will be charged a \$15.00 late fee and will be put on a waiting list. Those players on a waiting list cannot be guaranteed a spot on a team.
